



9. This form is generated by selecting “Estimated Financing.” It is a 2 page document that pulls together all your financial aid information from the previous sections. The second page shows an estimated cost of attendance (like shown in “Costs,” these numbers are **not** your actual costs).

All financial aid is estimated and can change due to numerous factors such as academic progress, transfer credits, etc.

All students must maintain satisfactory academic progress in order to maintain eligibility to receive financial aid.

Direct Loan disbursement amounts listed above do not reflect origination fees assessed by the lender (federal government). Student loan net disbursement amounts will be credited to the student's account. If the total amount of Title IV funds credited exceeds the amount of charges for the term, CTS will issue a refund check no later than 14 days from the date funds are disbursed to the school. Students may cancel all or any portion of their Direct Loan or Loan disbursement within 30 days of a credit to their account.


